WHEREAS, the property known as "Potts Place" contains historically significant outbuildings; and

WHEREAS, the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Historic Properties Commission has demonstrated the historic significance of the building and property known as "Potts Place;" and

WHEREAS, the Division of Archives and History of the North Carolina Department of Cultural Resources has endorsed the findings of the Charlotte-Macklehourg Historic Properties Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT CREATED by the Board of County Commissioners of Macklemburg County, North Carolina:

 That the building and property known as "Potts Place," located on the Smith Rd. in Mecklenburg County, is hereby designated as historic property pursuant to Part 38, Article 19, Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina.

Nothing herein shall be construed to prevent the property owners from making any use of this property not prohibited by other statutes, ordinances, or regulations.
- 4. That a suitable sign shall be posted indicating the said building and property's designation as historic property and containing any other appropriate information. If the owner consents, the sign shall be placed upon the said building or property. If the owner objects, the sign shall be placed on a nearby public right of way.
