**1. Chair's Report: Mr. Jeff Parsons, HLC Secretary and Survey Committee Chair**

**3. Consulting Director's Report: Dr. Dan Morrill**

**Dr. Morrill reviewed the purpose of the Survey Committee, which is to recommend the placement of properties on the Study List of Prospective Historic Landmarks, to recommend the preparation of Survey and Research Reports on Prospective Historic Landmarks, and to recommend to the Historic Landmarks Commission the processing of properties for Historic Landmark designation.**

**4. Review of the Survey and Research Report on the Former Charlotte Fire Station Number 10, 2136 Remount Road, Charlotte, N.C.**

**Dr. Morrill reviewed the Survey and Research Report on Former Charlotte Fire Station Number 10, 2136 Remount Road, Charlotte, N.C.**

**MR. ROGERS PRESENTED A MOTION SECONDED BY MR. EGLESTON THAT THE SURVEY COMMITTEE RECOMMEND TO THE HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMISSION (HLC) THAT THE HLC RECOMMEND TO THE CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL THAT IT DESIGNATE THE FORMER CHARLOTTE FIRE STATION NUMBER 10, 2136 REMOUNT ROAD, CHARLOTTE, N.C., AS A HISTORIC LANDMARK. THE LANDMARK SHALL INCLUDE THE INTERIOR OF THE BUILDING, THE EXTERIOR OF THE BUILDING, AND THE ENTIRE TAX PARCEL ASSOCIATED WITH THE SUBJECT PROPERTY. THE COMMITTEE UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED THE MOTION.**

**5. Consideration of Future Areas of Concentration for Preparing Survey and Research Reports**

**Dr. Morrill reported that Staff would be developing a list of recommended properties on which Survey and Reports would be prepared. The report will be presented at the November meeting of the Survey Committee. Dr. Morrill said that Staff would welcome recommendations from individual members of the Committee. Dr. Morrill stated that the Rudisil Gold Mine and other gold mines in Mecklenburg County represent a transformative event in the history of Charlotte-Mecklenburg. Therefore, Staff believes that the preparation of a Survey and Research Report on the Rudisil Gold Mine is justified.**
