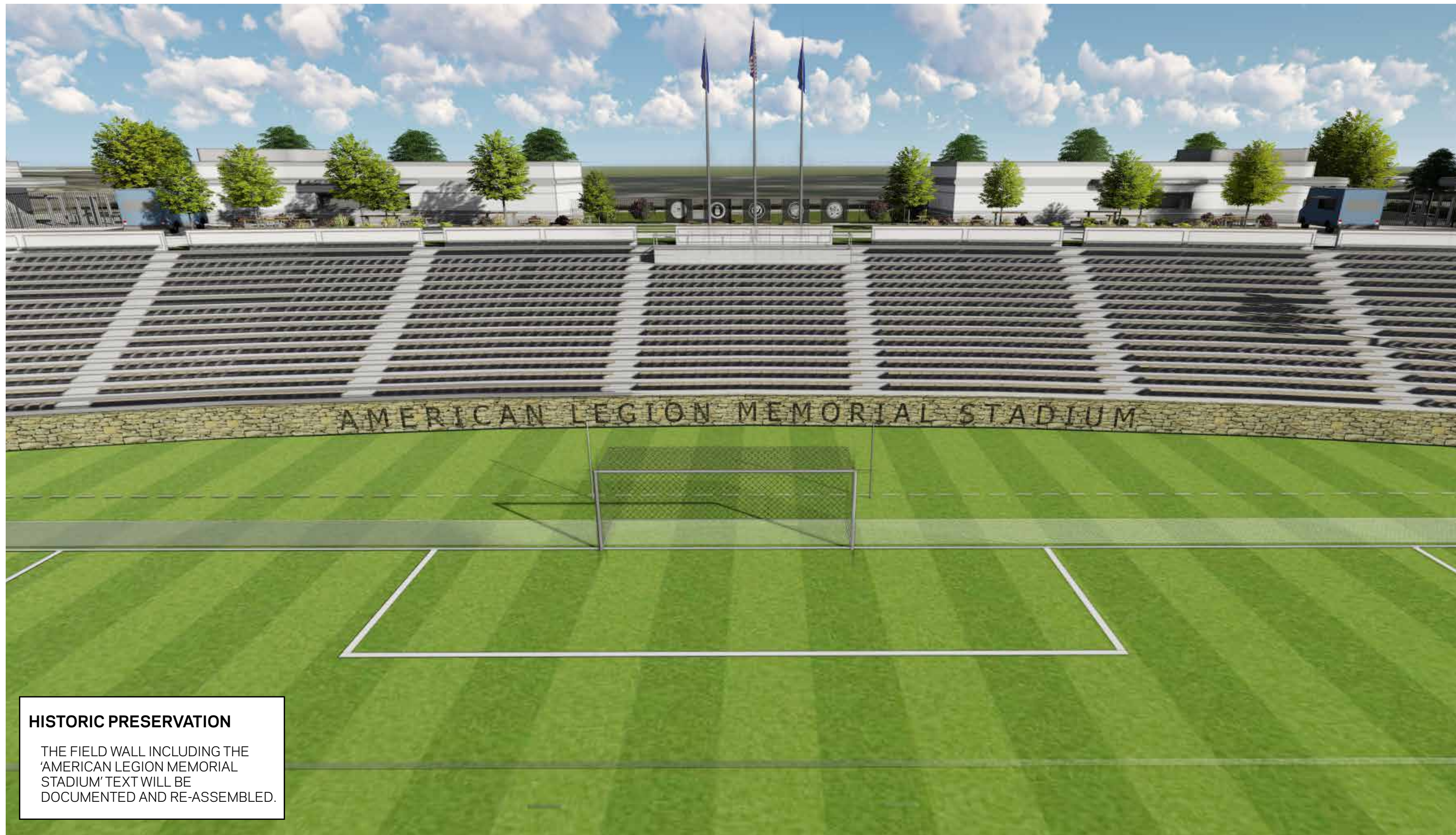

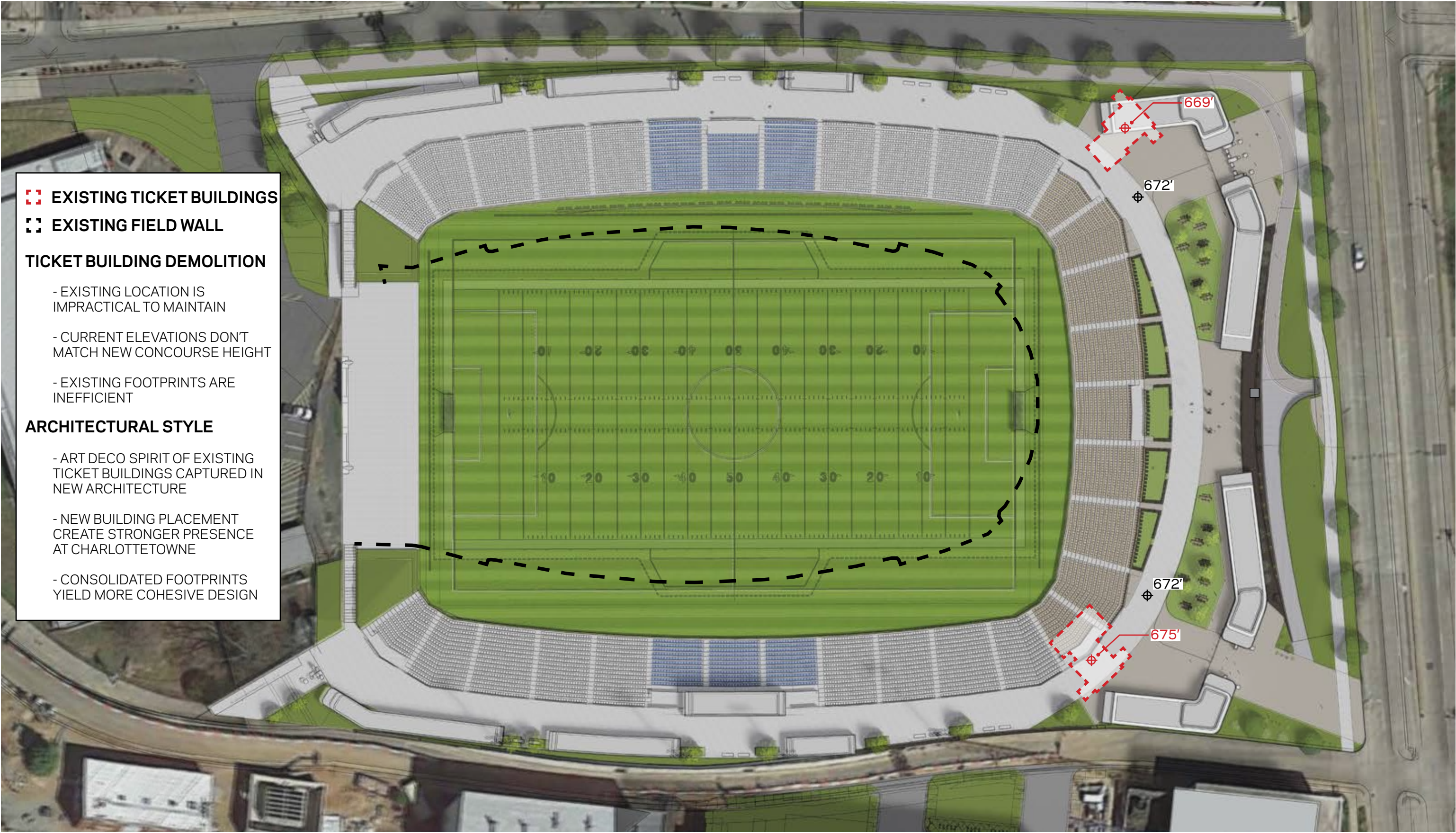
KEY DESIGN ELEMENTS

- FIELD WALL ARC PRESERVED
- FIELD WALL REMAINS STONE
- STADIUM NAME PRESERVED AT SOUTH-END FIELD WALL
- REPLICATION OF WALL AT THE BACK OF THE SEATING BOWL
- GREENWAY CONNECTION ENHANCED

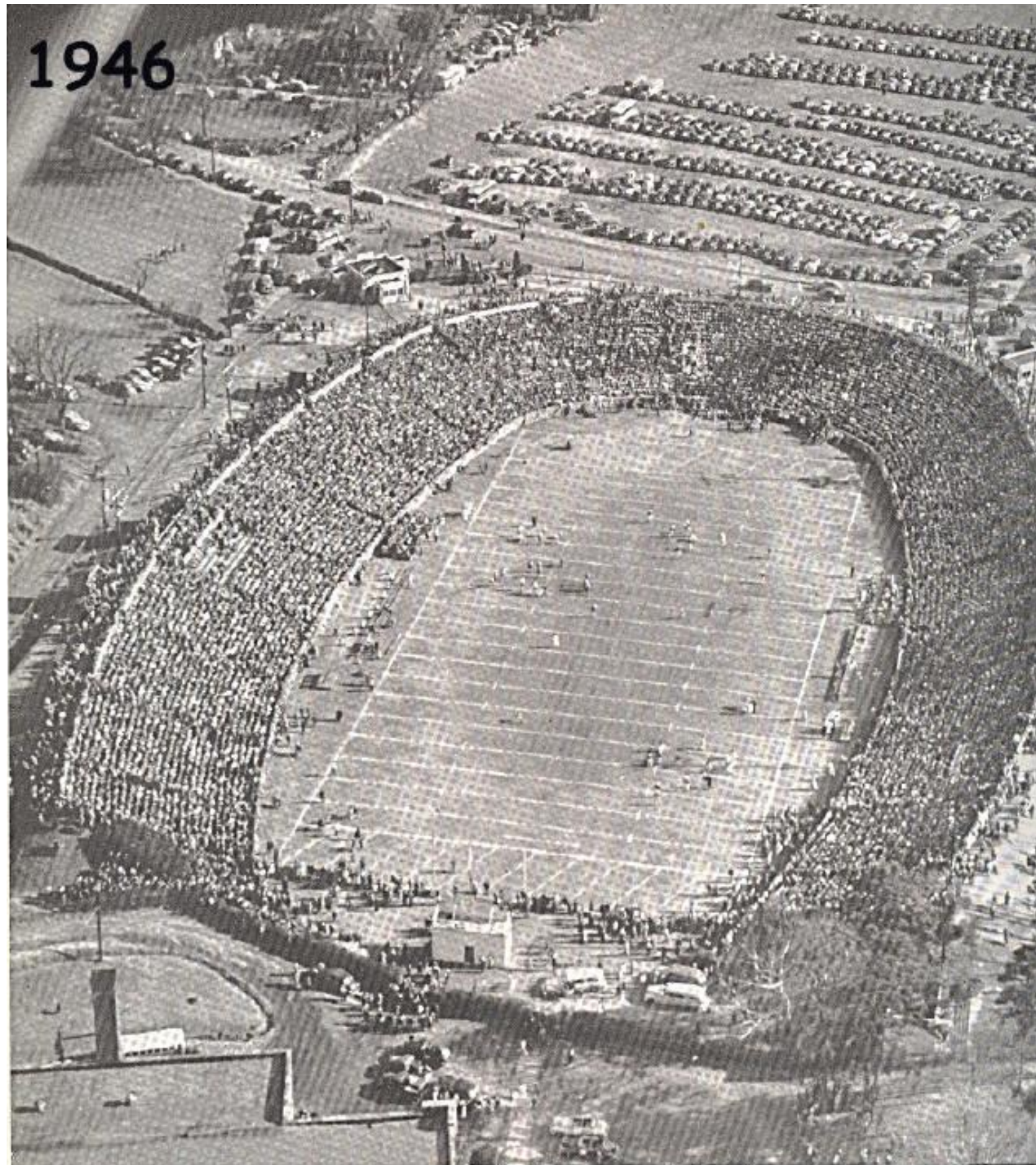
EXISTING FIELD WALL

TICKET BUILDING DEMOLITION

- EXISTING LOCATION IS IMPRACTICAL TO MAINTAIN
- CURRENT ELEVATIONS DON'T MATCH NEW CONCOURSE HEIGHT
- EXISTING FOOTPRINTS ARE INEFFICIENT

ARCHITECTURAL STYLE

- ART DECO SPIRIT OF EXISTING TICKET BUILDINGS CAPTURED IN NEW ARCHITECTURE
- NEW BUILDING PLACEMENT CREATE STRONGER PRESENCE AT CHARLOTTETOWNE
- CONSOLIDATED FOOTPRINTS YIELD MORE COHESIVE DESIGN





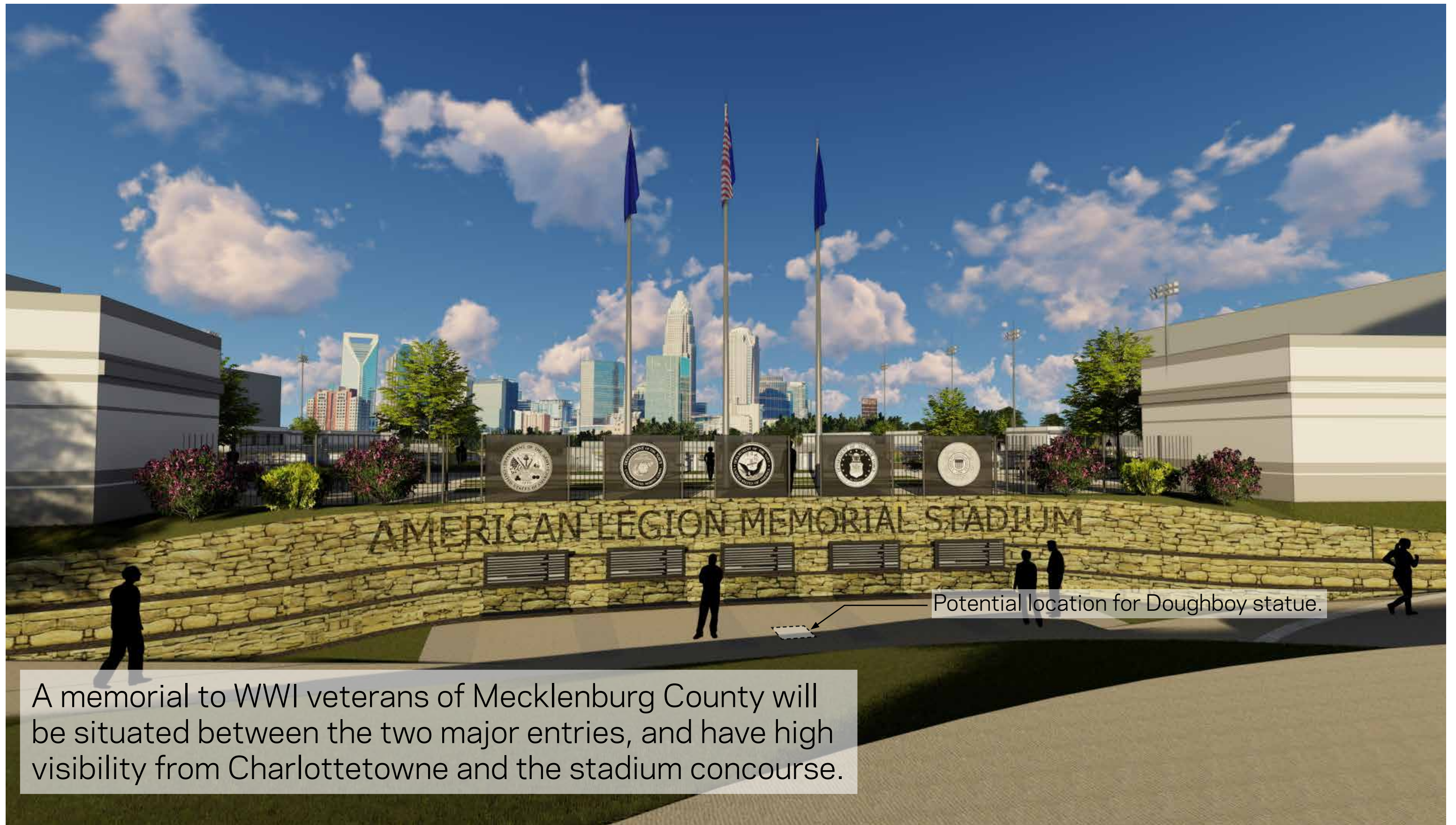

A memorial to WWI veterans of Mecklenburg County will be situated between the two major entries, and have high visibility from Charlottetowne and the stadium concourse.
