HARDSCAPING AND OTHER DETAIL NOTES	
HH	Berm created between lower end of driveway and street, to camouflage complete view of automobiles while still allowing view of historic home from street, by lowering grade of driveway here below existing grade of naturally-sloped front yard.
II	Triangular "view easement" from adjoining lot, already approved by owner.
JJ	Existing front auto court to remain as original, in geometrics, brick pavers, and Art Moderne steps opposite from front door. Existing columns flanking these steps to remain also, but adjacent wall lengths to be truncated as shown, then new driveway shape is completed as shown for symmetry and complete circulation. Same concrete curb profile as original to be added where needed all along brick-and asphalt driveway.
KK	12' diameter small patio outside "servants' entrance", enclosed by circular brick wall very similar to original wall, sloping down in height from 8' @ house-end to 3.5' @ free end, terminated by circular brick column. (All vertical brick masonry shall be painted to match house color).
LL	Swimming pool on uppermost terrace. Shape to echo smaller original Beaux Arts-styled fountain that was in this location: pool approx. 18' W x 27' L with 8' x 8' spa at southern end and 8' x 8' sunning shelf at addition-end. Surrounding pooldeck 5.5' wide, with artificial turf surface per owner's desire.
MM	Wide concrete steps from addition: 3' depth landing (4" below FFE), with steps as shown, with their profile to match existing Art Moderne steps from house & terrace levels.
NN	New fireplace to occupy existing half-ellipse shape on midlevel terrace, with bluestone flooring in front. 5' width gravel path along center, flanked by plantings.
OO	Concrete pad poured adjacent to carport for trash-and-recycling storage.
PP	Retaining wall as shown, painted same color as house, in orthogonal layout based on house and terrace footprints. Stucco-over-CMU, with possible subtle brick-masonry detailing in some locations to echo checkered brickwork on house's rear elevation. Approx. 4.5' ht. (to also serve as code-required pool security). Hidden masonry strip @ base of street-side, where lawn is annexed adjacent. At south end, wall-return 'dies' back into slope, with pool fencing starting here to maintain req'd. safety height.
