


Proposed Landmark Polygon







b. Overview/Nature of Redevelopment. Redevelopment/development of the Site as contemplated by the Rezoning Plan involves both (i) an innovative, adaptive reuse of significant portions of the existing industrial/distribution buildings (e.g. Existing Buildings, as defined below) that were constructed as early as the 1920s and (ii) construction of New Buildings (as defined below) in areas where Existing Buildings do not now exist and in certain areas of the Site where Existing Buildings do exist but are not located within the Core Existing Building Areas (as defined below). The overall redevelopment to be known as "Camp North End" seeks to resurrect and





