Re: Potential activities to commemorate HLC's 50th anniversary

2023 marks the 50th anniversary of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Historic Landmarks Commission. The following is a preliminary list of potential commemorative activities that the Commission may wish to consider undertaking to mark the occasion while also increasing community awareness of and involvement with HLC.

- 1. Engage with county schools for a contest -e.g., art or poster contest, essay contest, public speaking contests focusing on designated landmarks and associated local history.
- 2. Engage with Discovery Place for a special child-friendly historic preservation exhibit, *e.g.*, how are older buildings preserved (incorporating hands-on do-it-yourself features), ecological benefits of adaptive reuse of old buildings.
- 3. Host a community-centric conference on grassroots historic preservation opportunities, resources, processes, etc. focused specifically on Mecklenburg County.
- 4. Launch a walking/driving tour app of designated historic landmarks within specific areas of Charlotte and for each of the county's other municipalities.
- 5. Launch a monthly blog for the anniversary year highlighting thematic subsets of designated properties, *e.g.*, location, municipality, era, architectural styles, types of landmarks.
- 6. The addition of new features to the HLC website:
  - a. An interactive story map or timeline describing HLC's evolution and successful projects; and
  - b. An interactive map identifying designated properties and linking each map location with the relevant HLC designation/survey and research report.
