Margie and Julius Goldstein House 447 Merwick Circle Charlotte, NC 28211

Brief Description of Property

Built in 1958 - The Margie and Julius Goldstein Residence, 447 Merwick Circle, Charlotte NC was designed by architect Albert (Al) Barnes Cameron, who worked for Odell and studied under Henry Kamphoefner at the NCSU School of Design. The Goldsteins lived there for over 50 years. Sold in 2010 to Mark and Catherine Merkel. Sold in 2018 to Heather St. Aubin-Stout and Gray Stout AIA. The home has been well maintained over the years and is a prime example of the mid century modern style, incorporating many of the trademark features of this period of design, such as post and beam structure, floor to ceiling windows and a central skylight over the kitchen.

The Goldsteins moved to Charlotte from Gaston County and raised their 2 children here. They chose this location to be close to and a part of the Jewish Community in Charlotte.

Gray and Hetaher added the swimming pool and landscaped rear yard in 2019. They also restored a rear door to the rear terrace that had been closed.
